- Consult with historians, archaeologists, or relevant experts when developing or reviewing 3D models to ensure fidelity to the original artifacts or places.
- Provide feedback to the development team on potential inaccuracies or recommendations for enhancement.
- Optimization for AR/VR Rendering: Ensure 3D models are optimized for real-time rendering in AR and VR environments without compromising on visual quality.
